Cops and Rodders Friends,

Welcome to our 5th Tucson Cops and Rodders car show! I want to thank you for your participation because without you, there would be no show. The goal for our show is to facilitate your having a fun day while we support a very worthy cause; helping the Tucson Police Foundation support the Tucson Police Department and their important community programs. Let's start with some very important information.

- 1. There is no day of show registration. If you know someone who is thinking about coming to the show at the last minute, please share with them that we will not be accepting day of show registrations.**
- 2. The deadline for all registrations is Wednesday October 26, 2011. If we have sold out prior to the 27th we will shut down registrations earlier, this will not affect any of you, but if you get questions, please encourage those you know who have yet to register!**
- 3. Parking Instructions are enclosed and will help you get into the show and parked.**
- 4. Safe Trick or Treat for children starts at 11:00 AM at designated sites at the show. The Halloween Costume contest starts at 1:00 PM.**
- 5. There is free spectator parking and free shuttle at the El Con Mall North East Parking lot across from Home Depot/Target.**
- 6. There is a Help/Information Tent near the main entrance to the stadium, so if you have questions or need help you can go there for general assistance.**
- 7. Ballots will be placed in your goodie bag, Voting starts at 10:00 AM – ballot turn in at the Registration table by 12:00 noon. Remember in order to get your collectors dash plaque you must turn in your ballot.**
- 8. First Aid will be next to the information tent so if you need medical help it will be right next to the Information tent.**
- 9. Vehicle parking will be permitted starting Friday at 2:00 P.M. All trailer-towed vehicles are encouraged to arrive on Friday to limit day of show parking congestion. We have a large and secure storage area and lots of extra security this year.**

General Show Rules 2011

Day of Show Parking will commence at 7:00 A.M.

- 7:00–10:00am: Parking, Check-in and Registration.
- Vehicles with trailers must be brought on Randolph Way from E. 22nd street, at 6:30 A.M. for the trailer to be parked.
- 10:00 AM: National Anthem and the posting of colors
- 8:00am: Weigh-in for Kids' Pine Car Derby Race
- 9:00 am: Pine car derby starts, Pedal car races start
- 10:00 am: Hot Wheels Racing
- 10:00am–12:00pm: Judging by participants, and sponsors (Participants, take your ballot to the registration table, to get your dash plaque.)
- 11:00 – 1:30 P.M. Safe Trick or Treat
- 1:30 – 2:00 P.M. Halloween Costume Contest (at the main stage)
- 2:00- 3:00 P.M. Awards program starts. (at the main stage by the ticket office)
- 3:00 – 3:30 P.M. Major Raffle Prizes Awarded! (at the main stage)
- Please no independent sales of raffle tickets unless prearranged with the Show Director
- Note the show directors have the right to change any class prior to the day of the show and participants will be advised.
- Please turn off "Boom Boxes." This minimizes disruption to the residential area by the stadium.
- No "Independent Displays with chains, ropes or stanchions or prior trophies". Book and photos ok, in or on car.
- **No Personal Spirituous Liquor, Drugs, or Guns.**
- For Sale signs allowed if in good taste.
- You may bring a small pop up for shade as long as it is properly secured to the satisfaction of the show directors. Pop ups will not interfere with the ability of other participants to park.
- Bicycles are not permitted in the car show display area, unless part of a display.
- **No Dogs**
- No Refunds.

Please don't rev your engines or race, or "Burn out" leaving the show.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Parking will begin on Friday afternoon at 4:00 P.M. or Saturday morning at 7 A.M.

- **Post your parking pass in your window to be checked as you arrive.**
- **Have your registration placard in the window of your vehicle at all times during the show.** (Those vehicles without a placard will be asked to leave or be removed from the show.)
- **Car Clubs and Groups** please stage off site and all drive in together. We can accommodate you as long as you all arrive together.
- If you have multiple vehicles you will be allowed to park all of your vehicles in one class area if you choose. Please bring all of your vehicles to the show at the same time, Friday if possible.
- Only one parking space per vehicle is permitted
- Clubs coming in on Friday can have designated spots.

The following vehicle classes must use the North Entrance

Class 1: Special Classes Class 4: Foreign Cars
Class 5: Public Safety – Military Vehicles

The above classes will enter show parking by accessing South Randolph Way from East Broadway Boulevard. Broadway is the street that passes in front of El Con Mall. There is a traffic signal at this location. Please proceed South on Randolph Way until you reach show parking. You will be directed to parking from there.

The following vehicle classes must use the South Entrance

Class 2: Domestic Cars Class 3: Trucks
Class 6: Motorcycles

(Motorcycles will be parked in the Concourse Area on the 3rd Base side of the stadium)

The above classes will enter show parking by accessing South Randolph Way from East 22nd street. There is a traffic signal at this entrance and you will proceed North on Randolph until you reach show parking. You will be directed to parking from there.

Vehicles with Trailers: Enter via the South (22nd Street) Entrance. All show vehicles on trailers will be directed to the trailer unloading area in the far south parking lot, (see map). There, trailer unloading officers will direct the driver to unload the vehicle, park the vehicle in a temporary parking lot and then move the trailer to the Trailer Parking in the Equipment Yard South of Hi Corbett Field. No trailers will be allowed to remain in the Trailer Unloading area. When you return to your vehicle you will be directed to the appropriate parking lot. **Those with trailers are strongly encouraged to come Friday and park!**

Show parking concludes at 10:00 am

Remember to have your parking pass in your window and proof of registration with you.
(This is your email confirmation or your post card confirmation if you do not have email.)
